### Class Description

Learn how to do your own hems, reinstall zippers and mend or put on patches. Also, sew on buttons the correct way and get topstitching right.

**MACHINE:** bring In good working order plus: manual, all regular tools & accessories, & all your optional feet (you never know!)

**basic supplies** include: fabric scissors, thread snips, washaway marker, glass head pins only, Schmetz universal needles, measuring tape & any "can't do withouts"

**Personal:** pen and pencil, (opt: water bottle), Bag lunch for all-day class

*Please arrive 5—10 min. before to set up,  
and allow for 15 min cleanup  
Let us know ahead if you need special seating*

### Fabrics to bring:

A garment needing new buttons  
a garment needing zipper replacement  
a garment needing hemming  
a garment needing a patch or mend

### Accessories to bring

Zipper foot for regular zippers\*  
Invisible zipper foot if you are replacing an invisible zip\*  
Blind hem foot\*

### Notions to bring

Buttons and thread for the above garment\*  
A replacement zipper for the above garment, 1-2" longer than the original IF it is a pant or skirt. For a jacket, get the correct length (note – we do not carry zippers)  
Threads for the above garments\*

\* can be purchased at class—we thank you for your business

### Instructor's Special Preparation Notes

Do not worry if you don't have all the garments suggested. You will learn a lot seeing other people's repair needs. Or you could bring practice fabric.

You will need a *good* stitch ripper, get one from our selection please.
